The EU has also adopted sanctions against:

- **Belarus**, in response to its involvement in the invasion of Ukraine
- **Iran**, in relation to the use of Iranian drones in the Russian aggression against Ukraine

EU restrictive measures against Russia over Ukraine (since 2014)

Financial sector:

- restricted access to EU primary and secondary capital markets for certain Russian banks and companies
- prohibition on transactions with the Russian and Belarusian central banks, and with the Russian regional development bank
- SWIFT ban for certain Russian and Belarusian banks
- prohibition on the provision of euro-denominated banknotes to Russia and Belarus
- prohibition on public financing or investment in Russia
- prohibition on investment in and contribution to projects co-financed by the Russian Direct Investment Fund

Energy:

- prohibition on imports from Russia of coal
- prohibition on imports from Russia of oil, with limited exceptions
- price cap related to the maritime transport of oil at \$60 per barrel
- prohibition on exports to Russia of goods and technologies in the oil refining sector
- prohibition on new investments in the Russian energy and mining sector

Transport:

- closure of EU airspace to all Russian-owned and Russian-registered aircraft
- prohibition on maritime transport of Russian oil to third countries (if bought above the price cap)
- closure of EU ports to Russian vessels
- prohibition on Russian and Belarusian road transport operators from entering the EU
- prohibition on exports to Russia of goods and technology in the aviation, maritime and space industry

Defence:

- prohibition on exports to Russia of dual-use goods and technology items
- prohibition on exports to Russia of drone engines
- prohibition on trade in arms and civilian firearms
- prohibition on trade in ammunition, military vehicles and paramilitary equipment

Raw materials and other goods:

- prohibition on imports from Russia of iron, steel, wood, cement and plastics
- prohibition on imports from Russia of gold
- prohibition on imports from Russia of seafood, spirits, cigarettes, jewellery and cosmetics

Services to Russia or Russian persons:

- prohibition to provide crypto asset wallet, account or custody services
- prohibition to provide architectural and engineering services
- prohibition to provide IT consultancy services and legal advisory services
- prohibition to provide advertising, market research and public opinion polling services

- prohibition to provide technical assistance, brokering services or financing or financial assistance (in relation to the maritime transport of Russian oil)
 - EU sanctions do not impact food security and cover only bilateral trade between the EU and Russia – not international trade.
 - EU sanctions explicitly exclude food supplies and fertilisers: **there are no sanctions on Russian exports of food to global markets.** Anyone can operate, buy, transport, ensure food and fertilisers coming out of Russia
